OCLC to Add SoftLine Databases

SoftLine, Inc. has agreed to OCLC s loading three SoftLine databases on the OCLC FirstSearch service. The three will be available via subscription-only access. They are: Ethnic NewsWatch, Women R and Alt*Health, which focuses on complementary and alternative approaches to health. Ethnic NewsWatch also will be available on the EPIC service. OCLC has not yet scheduled the loading of these databases, although Ethnic NewsWatch, which has the highest priority, is expected to be loaded in the first quarter of 1998.

OCLC Enhances FirstSearch Web

The following enhancements have been made to FirstSearch Web:

- Users can now look at related subjects by clicking on and searching the most frequently occurring subject headings from records retrieved by a search.
- A new browsing index improves FirstSearch s WordList functionality.
